## **DESCRIPTION**

This model is created by crocheting two rectangular pieces and joining them at the front.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Large Crochet Piece (Body)
- Begin with Bouquet 715: Chain 50 cm.
- Follow the details in Diagram 1 and repeat a total of 4 rows until the piece measures 105 cm.

## **Crocheting the Body:**


- 1. Chain 50 cm + 3 extra chains and turn the work to the reverse side.
- 2. Row 1: Work one double crochet (DC) in each chain across. Chain 4 and turn to the reverse side.
- **3.** Row 2: Skip the first dc from the previous row, then work 1 chain + 1 double crochet (dc), creating small squares. Continue across the row. At the end of the row, chain 1 and turn to the reverse side.
- **4.** Row 3: For each small square from the previous row, work 2 crossed double crochets backward into the double crochet of the square below. Repeat for all squares across the row. At the end, chain 1 and turn the work
- **5. Row 4:** Work one single crochet (sc) into each double crochet from the row below. This completes the pattern sequence.

Repeat Rows 1 - 4 to complete the piece, which should measure approximately 50 cm x 105 cm.

## 2. Small Crochet Piece (Chest Flap)

- Begin with Bouquet Colour 715: Chain 17 cm.
- Work 5 rows of single crochet (sc), then continue with the pattern sequence until the piece measures 31 cm.
- Finish with another 5 rows of single crochet.

Final Measurements: Approximately 25 cm x 35 cm.





#### **ASSEMBLY**

- 1. Match the points labeled A1 to A2 and B1 to B2 in the diagram.
- 2. Insert the small chest flap (marked C) into the opening in the center of the cardigan. Ensure corners **C** and **D** are aligned and sewn securely.
- 3. Attach 12 buttons to the small chest flap-6 on the left and 6 on the right.
- 4. For the sleeves, leave **10 cm** open at the ends for the cuffs and stitch the remaining sides to the body. Refer to **Diagram 2** for placement and details.

## **BELT SECTION**

• Using **Bouquet Unicolor Colour 3210**, work a round of **ribbed crochet stitches** around the front and back for **8 cm**.


## **FRINGES FOR SLEEVES**

• Using Bouquet Unicolor Colour 3210, create 10 cm long fringes along the lower sides.

## **NECKLINE EDGING**


- Using Bouquet Unicolor Colour 3210:
- 1. Row 1: Work 2 chains + 1 single crochet in each space.
- 2. Row 2: Work 2 single crochets into each space and finish the model.





A1 will be matched with A2.

B1 will be matched with B2.



C1 will be joined and knitted to C2.




