YARN : YARNART DOLCE VITA 3411 - 4 pcs

- 5 mm crochet hook
- 2 white shepherd-style buttons
- Yarn needle

We will begin our vest from the start of the back panel and crochet it horizontally in one single piece as follows: first the left back and left front, then the back neckline, then the right back and right front. (DIAGRAM 1)

CROCHET TECHNIQUE: Crochet brioche

STITCHES / TECHNIQUES USED :

- Chain
- Single crochet
- Single crochet worked in the back loop only (the single crochets should be worked loosely)

Using a 5 mm crochet hook, make a foundation chain measuring 140 cm. After the final chain, turn the work.

Row 1: Work single crochet all across.

(From Row 2 onward, and until the measurements for the left front and back sections are completed, all single crochets will be worked through the back loop only as described below.)

Row 2 : At the beginning of the row, make 1 single crochet. Then, insert the hook into the loop of the single crochet that is already on the hook, specifically into the loop from the last yarn-over and pull-through used to close it, and without completing the stitch or making any further action, keep that loop on the hook. While that loop remains on the hook, work 1 single crochet into the back loop of the next single crochet from the row below, then loosely work off the two loops on the hook together in one go.

After crocheting the left back and left front section to 140 cm in length and 20 cm in width, slip stitch across 70 cm of the left front section. For the back neckline, continue crocheting 10 cm more without cutting the yarn. After the neckline, again without cutting the yarn, chain 70 cm, equal to the left front section, and begin crocheting again so that the work once more reaches 140 cm. Turn the newly added 70 cm chain section and work single crochet on it; when you reach the neckline, continue again by working single crochet through the back loop as before. Work a further 20 cm in this manner to complete the crocheted body of the vest.

Place the crocheted piece on a table and fold it in half so that the side sections come to the front, forming the shape of the vest. Starting from the shoulder, leave a 20 cm armhole opening, then sew the two side edges together using a yarn needle.

Attach the shepherd-style buttons at 25 cm and 35 cm along the front neckline, and the model is complete.

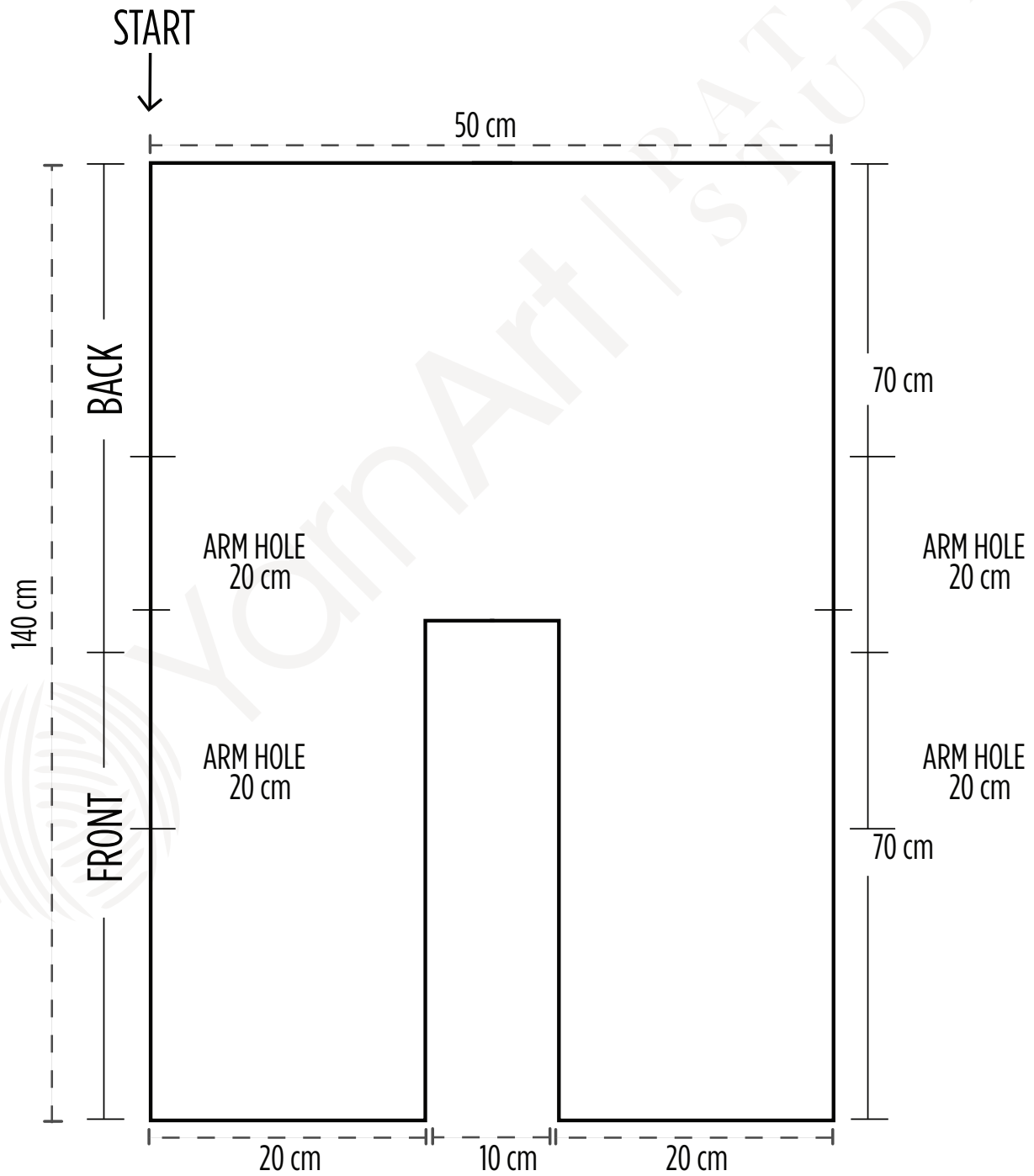
