YARN : YARNART STYLISH ALPACA 7703 - 3 pcs

HOOK : 4 mm

MARKERS : 4 pcs

SIZE : S

The model is started from the neckline and worked down, increasing at two separate corners, and finished at the hem. For the beginning, the fabric is formed by making small rings first, then working filled stitches onto these rings.

Start

CH 2, insert the hook into the 1st chain and make a DC (double crochet) by pulling through in 2 steps, forming a ring. CH 2, insert the hook into the 1st chain and make another DC by pulling through in 2 steps. Continue until you have 52 rings. Then, lay the rings flat on the table so they do not twist, and join to the top of the first ring with a SL ST.

Round 1

First, begin by making a corner. Into the same ring below, work 2 DC, CH 2, 2 DC, place a marker to mark the first corner. Into the next ring, work 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC (V-stitch), CH 2, skip 1 ring below, then into the next ring work 1 SC, CH 2, skip 1 ring below, then into the next ring work 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC (V-stitch). Continue in this way until the midpoint of the foundation rings. (DIAGRAM 2)

Make the second corner with 2 DC, CH 2, 2 DC. Then repeat the same sequence until the other corner: into the next ring work 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC (V-stitch), ch 2, skip 1 ring below, work 1 SC and CH2, skip 1 ring below, then work 1 DC, CH2, 1 DC. Repeat until reaching the other corner.

Round 2

Continue in a spiral without joining the rounds. For the corner of Round 2: work 1 front loop double crochet on top of the DC before the CH of the round below, then into the CH below work 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC, then work 1 front loop double crochet on top of the middle DC below. Into the space below work 1 SC. Into the adjacent V-stitch: on top of the first DC work 1 front loop double crochet, into the CH space below work 5 DC, and on top of the last DC of the V-stitch work 1 front loop double crochet, making a total of 7 filled stitches. Work 1 SC on top of the SC below, and continue in this way until the next corner. At the corner: on top of the DC below work 1 front loop double crochet, into the space below work 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC, on top of the middle DC below work 1 front loop double crochet, CH 2, on top of the single crochet of the round below work 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC, CH 2, on top of the middle of the 5 DC (i.e., the 3rd DC) work 1 SC, CH 2, into the next SC below work a V-stitch: 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC, CH 2. Repeat this sequence until the second corner. At the second corner: on top of the DC from the 2 DC below work 1 front loop double crochet, into the space below work 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC, on top of the first DC below work 1 front loop double crochet, CH 2, on top of the next SC below work 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC, CH 2, and work 1 SC on top of the middle (3rd) DC of the 5 DC in the 7-filled section. Repeat until reaching the other corner to complete the round.

Round 3

Repeat Round 1 excluding the corners. For the corners: on top of the DC before the CH below work 1 front loop double crochet, into the CH space below work 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC, and on top of the middle DC below work 1 front loop double crochet. The remaining sections are a repeat of Round 1.

Round 4

Repeat Round 1 excluding the corners. For the corners: on top of the DC before the CH below work 1 front loop double crochet, into the CH space below work 1 DC, CH 2, 1 DC, and on top of the middle DC below work 1 front loop double crochet. The remaining sections are a repeat of Round 2.

The entire model continues as repeats of Rounds 1 and 2.

For clearer understanding of the rounds, follow DIAGRAM 3.

Continue until the body measurement from the shoulder to the corner reaches 60 cm. Then place it on the table and match it up to form a triangle, with one corner aligning to the back center and the other to the front center. (DIAGRAM 4) The sleeve areas are the sections without increases. Join both sleeves in the same way, aligning 7 motifs on the front and 7 motifs on the back from the sleeve edge, and connect using markers. From this point on, stop working the body and work only the sleeves. From the round where you are, work 18 rounds to complete the sleeves.

Work 1 round of single crochet inside the neckline to finish the model.

- Slip Stitch (ST)
- Chain (CH)

- ∇^{oo} Corners
 - 1 Front Loop Double Crochet (FLO DC)
 - 1 Double Crochet (DC) + 2 Chain

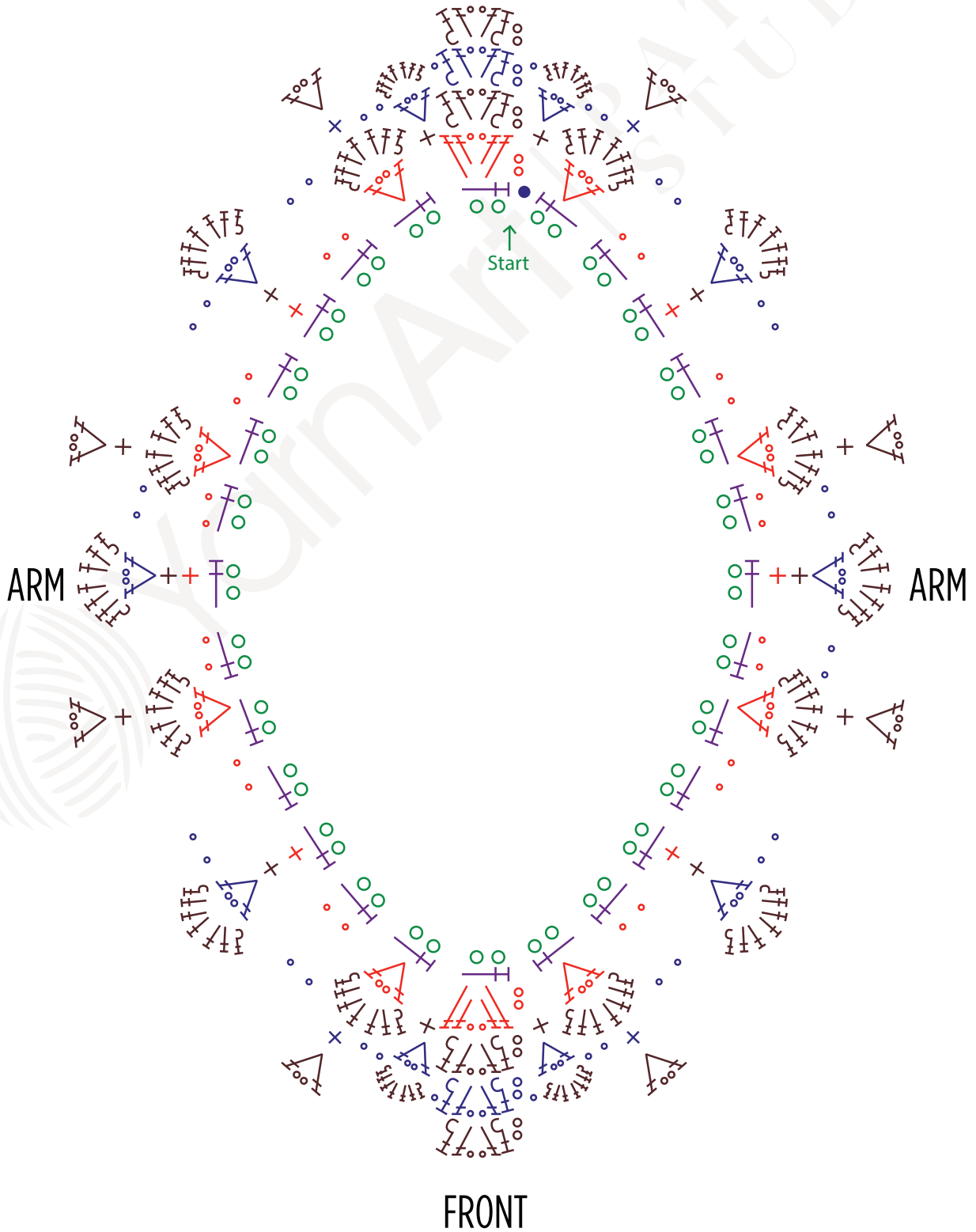


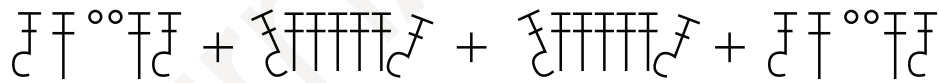
ROW-BY-ROW DIAGRAM

Start  1. DC (Double Crochet)
2. CH (Chain)

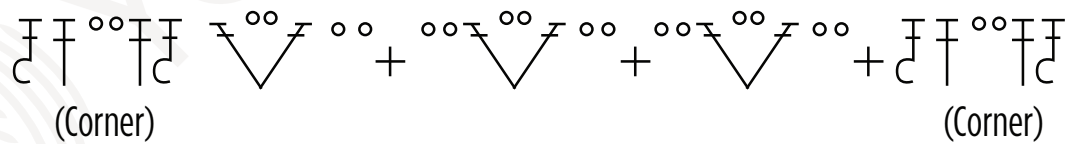
ROW 1: We begin by crocheting the first corner (back).



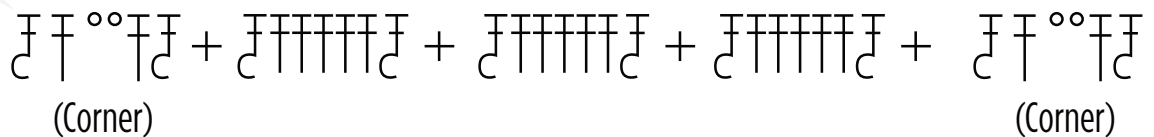
ROW 2:



ROW 3: Repeat Row 1, excluding the corners.



ROW 4: Repeat Row 2, excluding the corners.

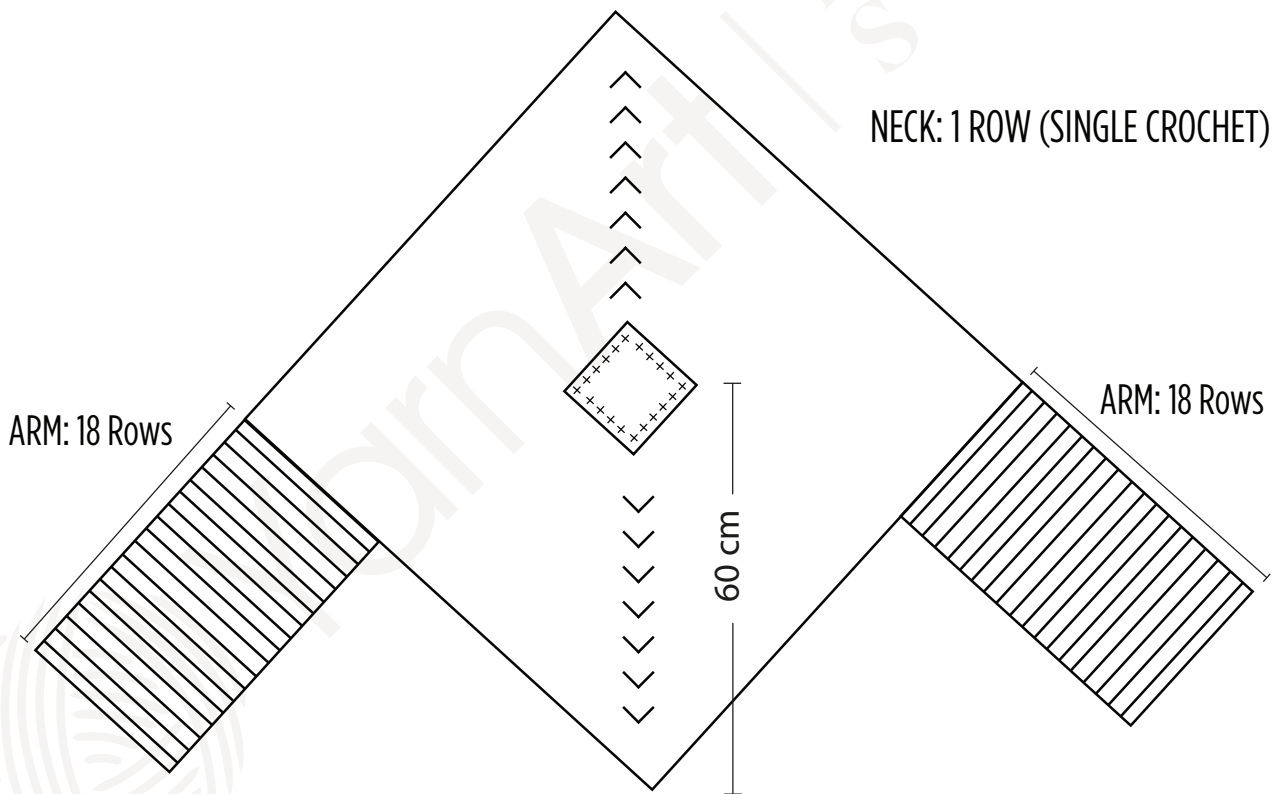


The stitches in the pattern are made by repeating Rows 1 and 2.
