



## SYMPHONY OVAL NECK BLOUSE

**YARN** : YARNART SYMPHONY 2101 - 5 pcs  
**HOOK** : 4 mm  
**SIZE** : S

#### Crochet Techniques Used

- chain
- double crochet
- treble crochet
- single crochet
- 3 double crochets into the same stitch

Used for the front, sleeves, and sleeve edges:  
 3 double crochets, 1 chain, 3 double crochets into the same stitch

This blouse is made by crocheting 4 pieces:  
 1 front, 1 back, and 2 sleeves.

First, we crochet the back body.  
 Using a 4 mm hook, loosely chain 96 + 1 turning chain, turn the work, and crochet 1 row in mesh pattern.  
 (1 double crochet, 1 chain = 1 DC + 1 CH)

#### Row 1

Complete the first row as follows:  
 1 single crochet + 3 chains + 1 single crochet + 3 chains

#### Row 2

Into the middle (2nd chain) of the 3-chain space from the previous row, make:  
 3 double crochets + 3 chains

Into the middle (2nd chain) of the next 3-chain space from the previous row, make:  
 1 single crochet + 3 chains

Into the middle (2nd chain) of the next 3-chain space from the previous row, make:  
 3 double crochets + 3 chains

Continue in this way to the end of the row.  
 The back body is completed according to the measurements shown in DIAGRAM 3.

## FRONT BODY

STAGE 1 – The oval section at the front neckline

### Row 1

First, we crochet the oval section at the center of the neckline.

Chain 28 + 2 + 28, making a total of 58 chains. Then chain 2 more to turn and turn the work.

Work 1 double crochet into each of the next 28 chains (28 double crochets side by side).

Into the next first chain, make 2 double crochets into the same stitch.

Into the next second chain, make 2 double crochets into the same stitch.

Then work 1 double crochet into each of the remaining 28 chains (28 double crochets side by side).

This completes the first row. Continue by chaining 2 and turning the work.

### Row 2

Make 27 double crochets.

Into the 28th double crochet, make 2 double crochets into the same stitch.

Into the next double crochet, make 2 double crochets into the same stitch.

Then into the last double crochet of the pair made in the previous row, make 2 double crochets into the same stitch.

This completes the first section.

Now we make the same shaping on the other side of the neckline.

Into the first double crochet where the 2nd increase was made in the previous row, make 2 double crochets into the same stitch.

Into the last double crochet right next to it, make 2 double crochets into the same stitch.

Then into the 28th double crochet of the previous row, make 2 double crochets into the same stitch.

Complete the row by making 1 double crochet into each double crochet to the end of the row.

In this row, a total of 12 double-crochet pairs are made into the same stitches.

We will complete the front oval piece by working this shaping for a total of 10 rows. (DIAGRAM 1)

There will be 4 shaping sections in total.

Crochet all around the oval neckline by chaining 2, turning the work, and working as follows:

1 double crochet + 1 chain + 1 double crochet + 1 chain

Cut the yarn.

### Row 2

Without working the 1st and 4th sections of the neckline where no shaping was made, we will work only the 2nd and 3rd middle shaping sections in order to flatten the oval appearance.

In the 1st shaping section of the row below, work:

1 treble crochet + 1 chain + 1 treble crochet + 1 chain + 1 treble crochet + 1 chain + 1 treble crochet + 1 chain

Then in the 2nd and 3rd shaping sections, work:

1 double crochet + 1 chain + 1 double crochet + 1 chain + 1 double crochet + 1 chain

Then in the 4th section, again work:

1 treble crochet + 1 chain + 1 treble crochet + 1 chain + 1 treble crochet + 1 chain + 1 treble crochet + 1 chain

In this way, we flatten the middle area as much as possible.

Continue as follows until the shoulder measurement on both sides of the neckline reaches 10 cm.

### Row 1

Fasten the yarn to the work and crochet around the middle neckline as follows:

1 single crochet + 3 chains + 1 single crochet + 3 chains

## Row 2

Chain 2 and turn the work.

Into the middle (2nd chain) of the 3-chain space from the previous row, make:  
3 double crochets + 2 chains

Into the middle (2nd chain) of the next 3-chain space from the previous row, make:  
1 single crochet + 2 chains

Into the middle (2nd chain) of the next 3-chain space, make:  
3 double crochets + 2 chains

Into the middle (2nd chain) of the next 3-chain space from the previous row, make:  
1 single crochet + 2 chains

Complete the row in this way.

Our work continues on 3 sides of the neckline in a U shape, by repeating Rows 1 and 2.

Until the shoulder measurements reach 10 cm, there will be a total of 4 repeats.

Once the shoulder measurement reaches 10 cm, stop crocheting at the neckline edges and continue only from the chest part of the body down to the hem of the blouse in the same manner.

(DIAGRAM 2)

After sewing and joining the front and back bodies, we complete the work by making the scalloped edging.

## SCALLOPED EDGE ROW

Into the same stitch, make 8 double crochets.

Without chaining, make 1 single crochet into the next mesh space.

Without chaining, make 8 double crochets into the same stitch in the next mesh space.

Continue in this way to the end of the row to complete the body.

## SLEEVES

After the front and back bodies are sewn together, fasten the yarn to the section that leaves 18 cm open at the front and 18 cm open at the back, starting from the shoulder and working downward toward the chest.

First, work 1 row of mesh pattern as:

1 double crochet + 1 chain

Then crochet the Row 1 and Row 2 technique explained above in the round for 20 cm.

After that, continue by shaping only on both sides of the work, widening the sleeve ends into a bell shape for 20 cm more, and finish the sleeve.

The sleeve opening will be approximately 30 cm.

For the sleeve edges and the middle of the oval neckline, work as follows:

Chain 3,

fasten into the place where the 1st chain was made,

chain 3, make 1 single crochet, chain 3,

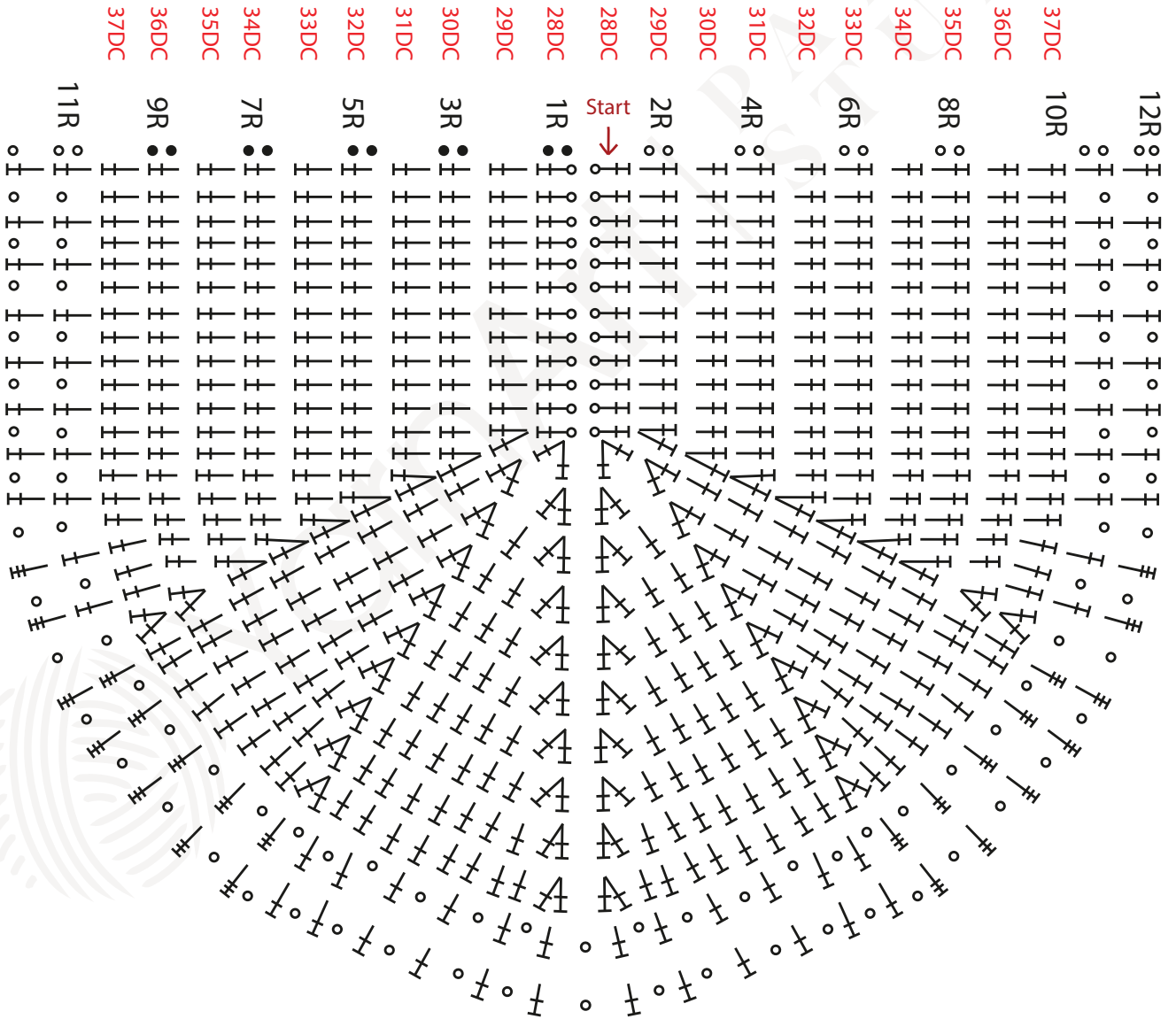
fasten again into the place where the 1st chain was made,

then chain 3 once more.

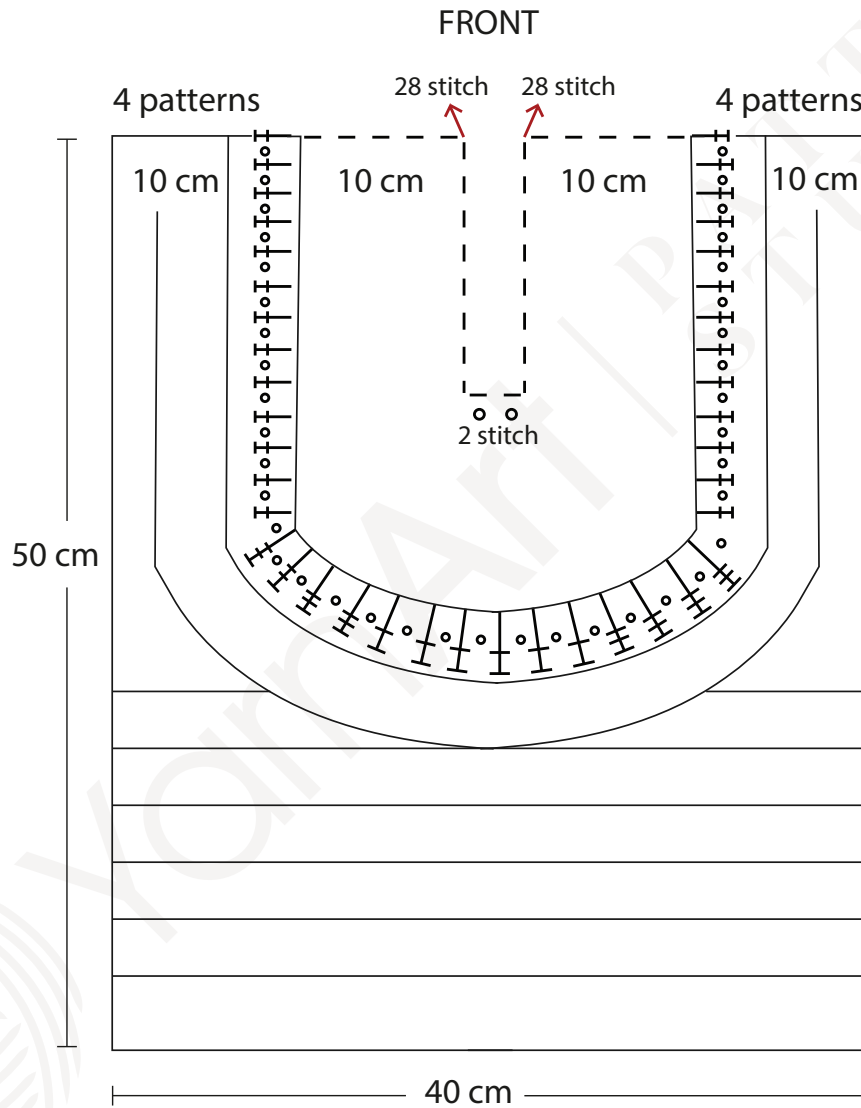
In this way, a picot-style edging is formed and the blouse is complete.

⋈ Double crochet

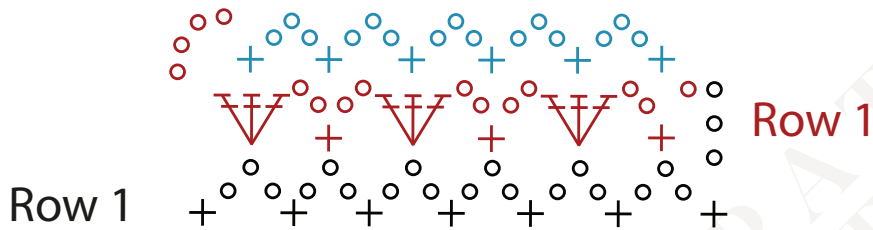
⋈ Treble crochet

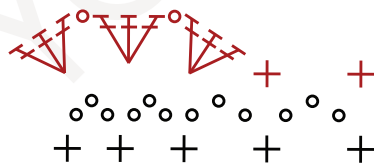
### DIAGRAM 3



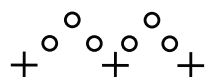
The front, back, and sleeves are worked by repeating Rows 1 and 2.

Sleeve edge increase: on both sides of the sleeve, at the same level.

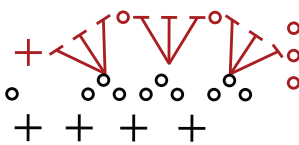
Increase
