YARN : YarnArt Crazy Color 148 - 5 pcs

HOOK : 4 mm + Sewing needle

SIZE : S

Techniques Used

- chain
- single crochet
- double crochet

Our model has been prepared as 3 pieces: the front and back are one piece, and 2 sleeves.

Our work will be set up horizontally according to the measurements of **Diagram 1**.

With a 4 mm hook, chains are made in multiples of 3 plus 2 chains (**112 cm**).

Row 1: Turn back with 2 chains and make 1 double crochet into each chain.

Row 2: Turn the work with 1 chain and complete the whole row with 1 single crochet, 2 chains, 1 single crochet, 2 chains.

Row 3: With 2 chains, make 3 double crochets into the 2-chain space of the lower row; 3 double crochets are made into all chain spaces.

Row 4: Turn the work with 1 chain and complete the whole row with 3 chains, 1 single crochet, 3 chains, 1 single crochet, 2 chains.

Our work is completed for the front and back body of the cardigan by repeating **Rows 1 and 2**. (**Diagram 2**)

Our work is laid out on the table by equalizing the front and back bodies. Leaving an 18 cm gap for the underarm, the sides of the cardigan are sewn.

Sleeves

The yarn is fixed to the space left for the sleeve and the crochet is started.

Row 5: Turn back with 2 chains and make 1 double crochet into each chain.

Row 6: Turn the work with 1 chain and complete the whole row with 1 single crochet, 2 chains, 1 single crochet, 2 chains.

Row 7: With 2 chains, make 3 double crochets into the 2-chain space of the lower row; 3 double crochets are made into all chain spaces.

Row 8: Turn the work with 1 chain and complete the whole row with 3 chains, 1 single crochet, 3 chains, 1 single crochet, 2 chains.

Again, our work is completed by repeating **Rows 1 and 2**.

After the body and sleeves, it is time to make the neck borders.

Row 1: The neck is completed with 1 double crochet, 1 chain, 1 double crochet, 1 chain throughout the whole row.

Row 2: The work is turned with 2 chains. 8 chains are made. Going backward, into the **4th chain**, 1 double crochet is made and pulled through once, leaving 1 loop on the hook. A **2nd** double crochet is made into the same point, pulled through once, and 2 loops are left on the hook. Finally, a **3rd** double crochet is made; with 3 yarn overs on the hook, it is pulled out at one time and a **bobble stitch** is made. 2 chains are made and, going backward, it is joined with a slip stitch into the **4th chain** where the bobble stitch was made, then 5 chains are made. Skipping 1 double crochet on the lower row, it is joined with a single crochet into the **2nd double crochet**.

Row 3: Going backward, into the area under the bobble stitch below, **3 rows (Rows 3, 4 and 5)** of mesh stitch are made: **(1 double crochet, 1 chain). (Diagram 3)**

For the neck, this crochet is repeated **3 times**.
(3 rows mesh, 1 row bobble stitch)

Thus, our model is completed.

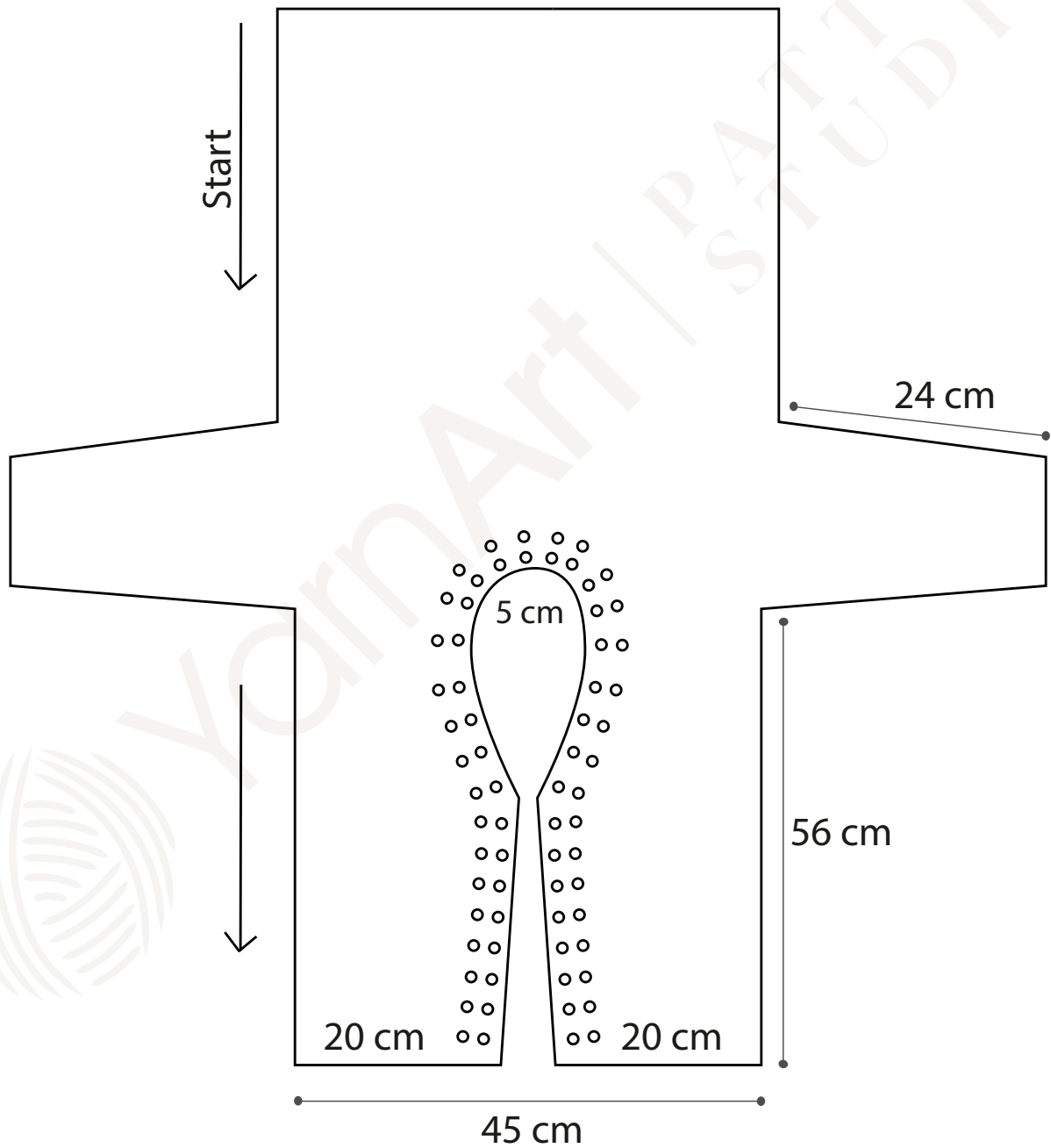
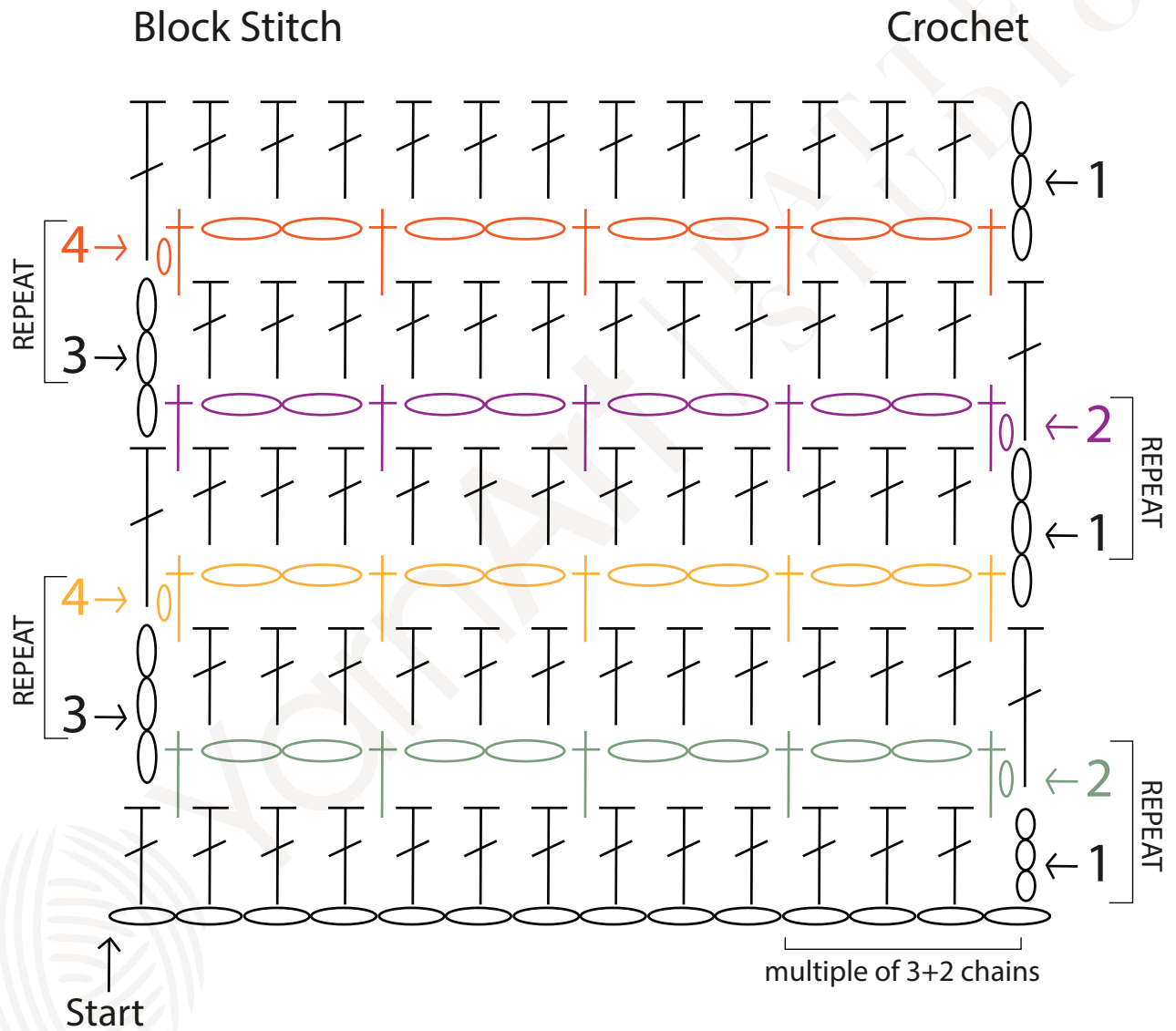

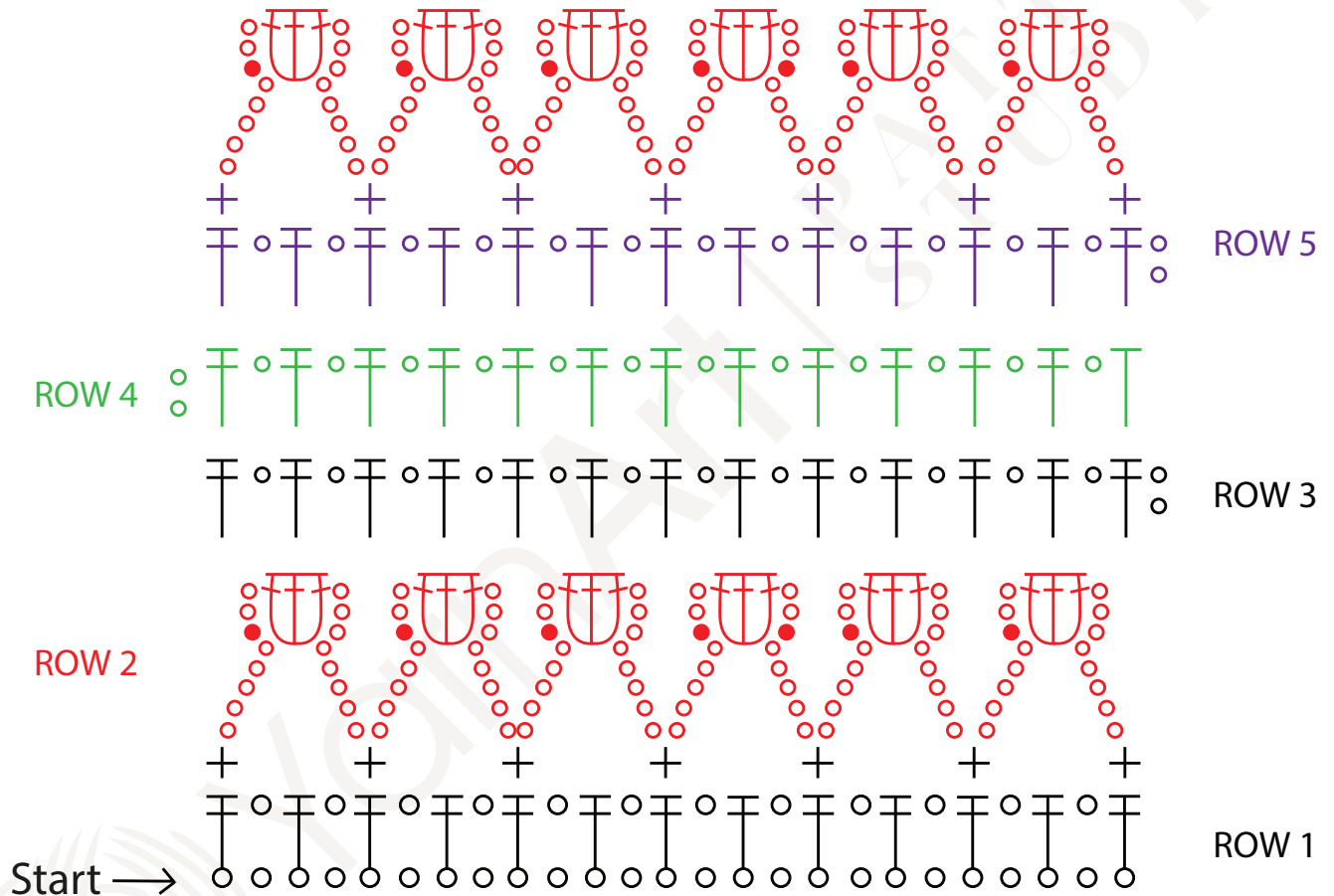

Border edging: 3 repeats

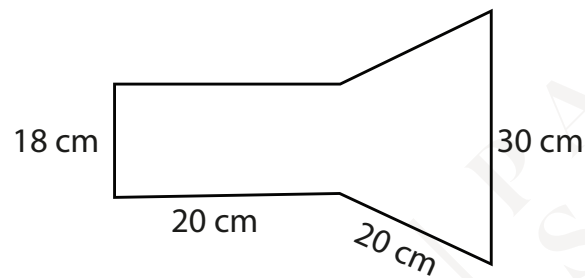

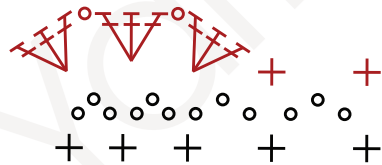

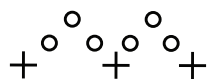
Arms



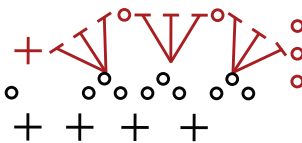
Increase

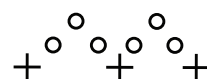
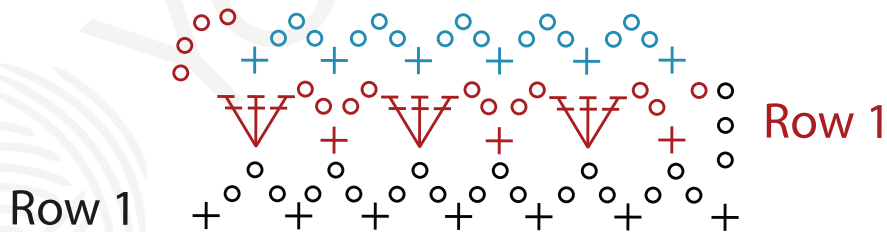
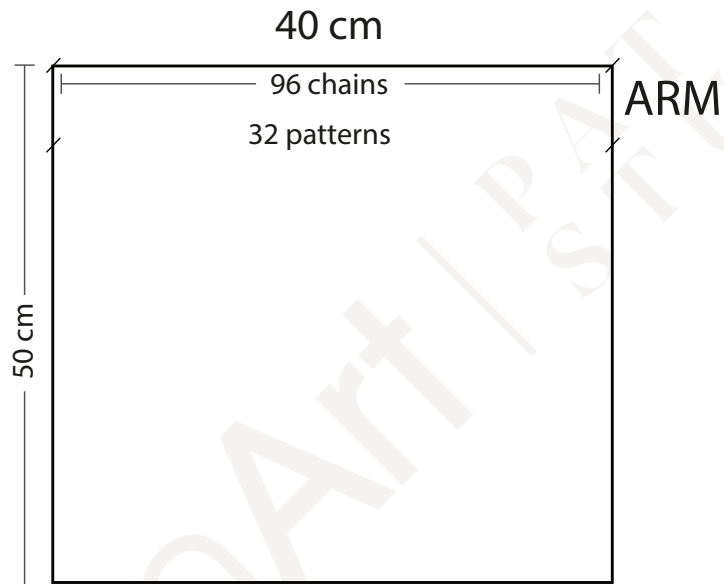


DIAGRAM 5

Arms



The front, back, and sleeves are worked by repeating Rows 1 and 2.

Sleeve edge increase: on both sides of the sleeve, at the same level.
