



FLOWERS V-NECK ONE-PIECE BLOUSE

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YARN : YarnArt Flowers 284 - 1 ball

NEEDLES : 3 mm circular needles

SIZE : S

For our blouse:

Using 3 mm circular needles, cast on 204 stitches and join carefully to work in the round, making sure the stitches are not twisted. We will begin by working these stitches in the round for both the front and back. The only seams will be at the sides of the blouse.

BEGINNING

1- Using 3 mm circular needles, cast on 204 stitches and join carefully to form a ring. Arrange 2 raglan stitches at the front and 2 raglan stitches at the back. Place a marker before each of these stitches and continue working. Increase at each of these 4 raglan stitches on every round to shape and enlarge the blouse.

2- Work 4 rounds in garter stitch (work continuously in either knit or purl stitches).

3- First, work 7 diamond motifs along the right front neckline edge, 7 diamond motifs along the left front neckline edge, and 1 diamond motif each at the centre front and centre back. **(DIAGRAM 1)**

4- Work 4 rounds in garter stitch.

5- Work 13 rounds in Honeycomb Stitch. The Honeycomb Stitch is worked as follows:

Round 1: Slip the first stitch purlwise without knitting, K1; repeat: slip 1 stitch purlwise, K1.

Round 2: Knit all stitches. (K)

Round 3: Knit the stitches that were slipped in Round 1 and slip the stitches that were knitted in Round 1. In other words, work the opposite of Round 1.

Work a total of 13 rounds in this manner.

6- Work 4 rounds in garter stitch.

7- Work the rib pattern 5 times. Work 4 rounds of ribbing, then reverse the ribbing in the following section, working purl over knit stitches and knit over purl stitches. **(DIAGRAM 2)**

8- Work 4 rounds in garter stitch.

9- Work 13 diamond motifs on the right front, 13 diamond motifs on the left front, 7 diamond motifs across the back and 7 diamond motifs across the front. **(DIAGRAM 1)**

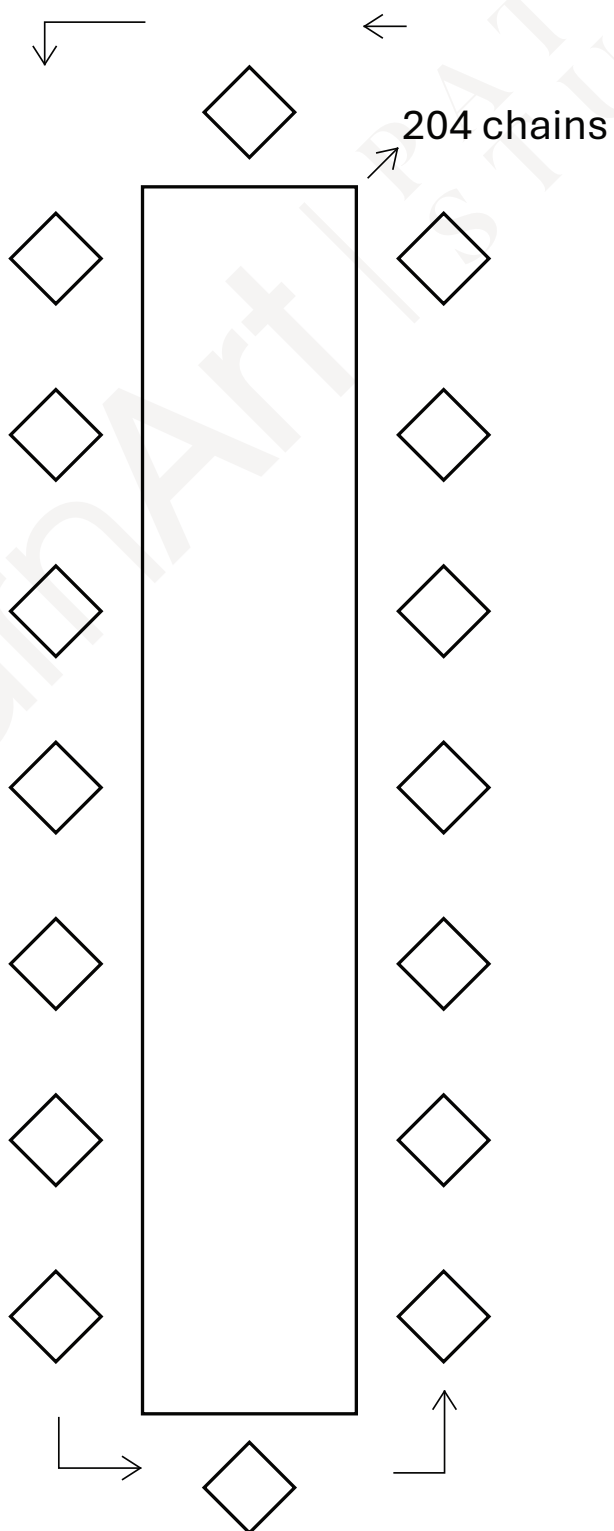
10- Work 4 rounds in garter stitch.

Seam the front and back together at both sides for 18 cm to complete the blouse.
